Background

This memorandum accompanies the City of Baltimore Mayor's Office of Recovery Program's submission of its monthly report to the City Council on spending and performance related to American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding. Specifically, Council Bill 21-0121 § 49-2(B) prescribes the elements of legislatively required reporting, which stipulates that monthly reports should:

- 1) Provide data and metrics regarding how the funds have:
 - I. Increased the effectiveness of city government services;
 - II. Broadened the reach of city government services;
 - III. Made city government services more efficient;
 - IV. Made city government services more sustainable

- 2) Identify key performance indicators, benchmarks, and targets related to:
 - I. Equity, as defined in Article 1, § 39-1 of the Baltimore City Code;
 - II. Population Growth;
 - III. Labor and Employment;
 - IV. Economic Growth, especially the growth of minority and women-owned businesses;
 - and,
 - V. Community Benefit

Commitments and Expenditures

Since the last report to City Council, total commitments have increased by \$19,568,290 which includes:

- \$16,160,000 through a fourth round of nonprofit awards
- \$4,160,000 for the Baltimore New American Access Coalition with the Mayor's Office of Immigrant Affairs

On August 8, 2022, the City of Baltimore completed Phase II of Workday implementation, transitioning all financial transactions from multiple legacy systems into one modern, cloud-based application. The Recovery Office and other City agencies are working to review and validate data that migrated to Workday. Once this review has been completed and any notable questions or discrepancies addressed, the Recovery Office will resume submission of monthly and cumulative expenditure data to City Council.

The fiscal administrators of the Economic Recovery Fund (ERF) maintain accounting systems that are separate from the City's Workday financial system. Each month, the administrators are required to report to the Recovery Office on their spend-down of the portion of the Fund that they are administering. Accordingly, the ERF expenditures shown in the Appendix have been updated to include data through September.

Performance Measures and Metrics

As previously noted, many agencies are still fully designing and implementing programs, therefore data are limited. Additional data on performance measures will be included in Council reports as programs are further implemented and data becomes available. The Recovery Office anticipates including some targets and benchmarks for agency performance during the FY23 period of performance. In the interim, the report includes narrative information on agency accomplishments to date. In addition, the Recovery Office is working with university partners and funded agencies and organizations in the coming months to establish equity-related targets based on best practices and available baseline data.

Population, Labor & Employment Growth

Council legislation requires key performance indicators, benchmarks, and targets related to population growth. No data source exists that would demonstrate population growth on a monthly basis. In addition, some ARPA funding may be used for programs and initiatives that could result in population growth. However, such instances would be anecdotal in nature, and cannot be positively correlated to ARPA.

The Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs has awarded ARPA funding for significant investments into small businesses, and non-profits with a prioritization on minority and women-led organizations. As previously noted, data are limited as programs are being implemented. The results of efforts to date are included in the Economic Recovery Fund portion of the report.

The Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs continues to make significant progress in the awarding of ARPA funds, the monitoring of agency and organization's progress, and in the accountability and transparency in the use of these funds. Information on awards, reports and the public-facing dashboard can be found at arp.baltimorecity.gov.

Commitments

Table 1 lists ARPA commitments through the month of September 2022, totaling \$555,381,877 with \$19,568,290 in commitments added in the month. Expenditure data for July-September 2022 will be presented in a future monthly report, as indicated in the cover memorandum.

Recovery Office Accomplishments

Since the last report, the Mayor’s Office of Recovery Programs announced its fourth round of funding commitments to 13 nonprofit organizations, totaling \$16.16 million:

- **Ahavas Chaim, Inc.** will receive \$500,000 to provide rent and housing security deposit support to residents impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Funding will be used to make facility improvements to the existing center which will allow for increased services designed to provide mental health, career, academic, and socioemotional support to at-risk teens and young adults in Baltimore.
- **American Communities Trust, Inc.** will receive \$2,250,000 to support a multi-phased project to eliminate the blight of five vacant and abandoned buildings to establish a small business jobs center in the heart of a persistent poverty community that was once an epicenter of business and retail. The job center will help to expand minority and locally-owned small businesses, create local jobs, and increase access to healthy foods.
- **Artspace** will receive \$300,000 to help redevelop the Ambassador Theater which will become a new art and cultural incubator and destination.
- **City Dibs** will receive \$500,000 to provide fellowships to entrepreneurs and business incubation support to existing small businesses in Baltimore City, with particular attention on serving Black and other minority populations.
- **Druid Heights Community Development Corporation** will receive \$300,000 to support the Green Infrastructure project, which will focus on stormwater management activities that

reduce inland flood and pollution for the vacant lots that have been impacted by repeated dumping from residential and commercial contractors.


- **Everyman Theatre** will receive \$1,000,000 to focus on restoring public performances and educational, arts and culture programming affected by the COVID-19 pandemic, with particular attention towards the equitable inclusion of groups that have been historically excluded or had limited engagement with Baltimore's arts, culture, and entertainment community.
- **HeartSmiles** will receive \$250,000 to provide mentorship, career advancement opportunities, leadership opportunities, and mental and physical health support to Baltimore City youth.
- **KEYS Empowers** will receive \$1,000,000 to help to transform the former Dr. Lillie M. Jackson Elementary School in the Coppin Heights neighborhood, into facility that will serve residents and more specifically, target the socio-economically underdeveloped Coppin Heights neighborhood. The complex will provide access to broadband internet and computer labs, nightly dinners in a fully equipped cafeteria, daily fitness programming in a gymnasium, job training in various industries including STEM, and mental health services.
- **Neighborhood Housing Services** will receive \$2,800,000 to support investment in comprehensive, equitable neighborhood development and affordable homeownership within Greater Rosemont Mondawmin (GRM) communities. This initiative will include developing vacant/disinvested units, providing home repairs and modifications, transforming a limited number of vacant lots, and removing blight across the community.
- **Omega Baltimore Foundation, Inc.** will receive \$260,000 to manage and operate the Easterwood Recreation Center in West Baltimore, in order to mitigate the lack of neighborhood recreational programming. The Easterwood Recreation Center will provide free hot meals and computer access to youth after school daily, Out of School Time STEM Programming for youth during the school year, summer camps, youth flag football leagues, and provide employment for neighborhood youth through YouthWorks.
- **Pennsylvania Avenue Black Arts and Entertainment District, Inc.** will receive \$1,000,000 to provide job training assistance, workforce development, cash assistance, and small business assistance in the form of sponsorships and fellowships for artists and creative professionals within the Black Arts District footprint.
- **Project PLASE** will receive \$3,500,000 to support the renovation of Beacon House Square (BHS) by covering hard costs related to construction of the affordable housing development.
- **Southeast Community Development Corporation** will receive \$2,500,000 to support affordable housing through the acquisition and rehabilitation of properties and a home repairs program focused on low-income owner-occupants and tenants.

Subawardee Accomplishments

Economic Recovery Fund

A total of 810 grants, totaling \$15,010,954 have been awarded from Economic Recovery Fund fiscal agents to beneficiaries to date, including nonprofits and small businesses (the full list of organizations is in the appendix). The map below indicates the location of all organizations funded through September 2022. Please note, some nonprofit organizations funded by BCF used their headquarters address on applications for funding. Though the location where services are rendered may not be specifically depicted in the map, sub-awardees provide services to a wide variety of neighborhoods across the City.

Baltimore Civic Fund (BCF) Economic Recovery Assistance

For the 2022 Nonprofit Relief Fund we received and approved 84 final reports. Subsequently, 84 grantees were paid a total of \$2,476,015.11. To date, we have paid 85% of awardees for the second round of the Nonprofit Relief Fund, and are hoping to complete 100% by October 31, 2022.

Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) Economic Recovery Assistance

BDC closed its second application window for small business grants on October 13, 2022. A total of 530 small businesses applied and requested a total of \$8.8 million. BDC is in the process of reviewing these applications and will make award determinations in the coming months. Two organizations selected for funding in Round 1 will not retain grant funds because one business is closing and returning funds, and another did not complete its grant agreement. To date, BDC has paid out \$3,266,690 out of its first round of funding, which totaled \$4,776,784, which represents 68% of Round 1 awardees. Given that BDC pays its awardees in two installments, 88 businesses to date have received both of their payments in Round 1 through the end of September.

Visit Baltimore Economic Recovery Assistance

Last month, Visit Baltimore conducted its 6-month follow-up survey of its 37 hotel and accommodations provider awardees. Across all awardees, there was a gain of 39 employees 6 months after receiving recovery assistance, which represent a 3% increase in employees since receiving awards. A total of 22 awardees (59%) gained employees, 2 awardees (5%) lost employees, and 13 awardees (35%) had the same number of employees 6 months after receiving recovery funds. Visit Baltimore has completely expended its funding at this time.

Baltimore Office of Promotion and the Arts Recovery Assistance (BOPA)

The Baltimore Office of Promotion and the Arts has awarded their final grant totaling 112 individual artist grant recipients. The total grant amount of \$500,000 has been expended. BOPA is in the process of creating a survey to ensure the collection of six-month and 12-month survey for response by each recipient.

Family League Economic Recovery Assistance

The Family League of Baltimore City has expended its \$2 million grant award and disbursed funds to 182 child day care providers. No new updates will be provided until the 12-month post-award survey is conducted and summarized.

City Agencies Accomplishments

Baltimore City Recreation and Parks (BCRP)

BCRP was awarded \$41 million to modernize the City's recreation and park facilities, including pools, recreations centers, playgrounds, athletic courts, and trails. The Greater Model pool, Gardenville Rec Center, Furley Rec Center, and Curtis Bay Rec Center are currently in design, while BCRP is preparing the Parkview Recreation Center project to bid for construction. BCRP and the Recovery Office are researching agreement types that would assist with expediting the completion of projects while also adhering to federal requirements.

Baltimore City Health Department (BCHD)

The Health Department addressed invoice issues which will allow them to move PPE and associated staff into the new warehouse. Additionally, BCHD is continuing its recruitment efforts for its adult guardianship, Aging Nutrition Fellow, and Food Security Clinical Health Workers. BCHD is also cross-training some of its COVID-19 contact tracers to conduct monkeypox contact tracing and outbreak investigations. Finally, BCHD's programming to provide meals to seniors, stand up mobile clinics and Fall vaccine campaign, and offer COVID testing is ongoing.

Broadband and Digital Equity (BDE)

BDE continues to bridge relationships with stakeholders. BDE connected BCRP and Pratt Libraries to develop Tech Hubs in every recreation center. In addition, September marked the end of the Affordable Connectivity Program Awareness Campaign. BDE is also engaging local innovators to develop Digital Equity programming through recreation centers and senior centers. A beta test of programming for seniors is in development. Finally, BDE is conducting interviews for the two key roles: project manager and network engineer and has recently onboarded a Digital Equity Coordinator.

Mayor's Office of Children and Family Success (MOCFS)

CASH Campaign continues to disburse monthly payments to approved program participants, provide services like financial counseling to participants, and collect performance and program evaluation data. Baltimore started disbursing monthly payments to approved program participants on August 15, 2022. On October 12, 2022, the Baltimore Banner published an [article](#) about the effect of these funds on the daily lives of participating residents.

Mayor's Office of Homeless Services (MOHS)

The Recovery Office has fully executed three grant agreements: Housing Navigation and Landlord Engagement; the Rapid Resolution and Shelter Diversion Fund; and Shelter Demobilization. There are two remaining projects that require executed grant agreements: the Housing Accelerator Fund and Shelter Acquisition. Both project agreements are expected to be executed in the coming months.

Mayor's Office of Neighborhood Safety and Engagement (MONSE)

The Community Engagement and Opportunity team updated the original process mapping sequence for coordinating Neighborhood Stabilization Response efforts to better coordinate interagency and community-based response activities to address gun violence events.

The Gun Violence Prevention team has had success with school-based violence intervention programming. The team met with the Baltimore City Public School Administration, Principals of high schools, and the Baltimore City Public School Police to develop programming piloting in three city high schools.

MONSE continues to move grants through the BoE process to provide funding to community-based organizations. A total of 8 grant agreements have been approved by the BoE and three agreements are on the upcoming November 2, 2022 BoE agenda. Additional agreements are under review.

Mayor's Office of Employment Development (MOED)

Eighteen Train Up Occupational Skills training providers continue to provide services, including 7 funded by the City ARPA allocation. All Support Services and Community Connectors contracts are also in place and services have begun. A total of 325 participants enrolled in Train Up Occupational Skills Training, of which 109 are with City ARPA-funded programs. In total, 99 enrollees have obtained certifications, 100 have completed their training, and 22 have gained employment with an average wage of \$19.18 (includes City and State ARPA funded programs). Most completers are still in their job search phase, and more placements are expected next month.

Through the Hire Up program, a total of 146 unemployed/underemployed Baltimore City residents have received subsidized employment—26 of which are funded by the City ARPA allocation. Including State-funded slots, 25 participants that remained in the program at least two weeks have transitioned to unsubsidized employment, 18 of whom reported an entry wage of \$15/hour or higher. Currently worksites include: MOED, the Baltimore City Department of Transportation, Department of Finance, Baltimore City Recreation and Parks Department, Department of Public Works, Parking Authority of Baltimore City, Downtown Partnership of Baltimore, and the Mayor's Office of African American Male Engagement, which also operates another worksite, The Food Project.

Hire Up and Train Up Project Managers continue to coordinate legal services through two providers—Maryland Legal Aid and Maryland Volunteer Lawyers Service. In addition, Associated Catholic Charities continues to provide behavioral health services. To date, at least 30 participants have taken advantage of free legal services, and 100 participants have been linked with behavioral health services.

Through the Small Business Wage Subsidy, a total of 285 unemployed or underemployed residents have been hired at small, minority- or woman-owned businesses, and 195 subsidies have been paid to businesses thus far (paid upon 10 weeks of employment). A total of 105 of these subsidies are supported by the City ARPA allocation. About 95% of hires have been remained in their positions after 10 weeks.

YouthWorks made offers to 6,761 youth for five-week jobs running from July 5 through August 5, 2022. Based on post-program survey results, 90% of youth workers expressed a positive experience and 89% reported an increase in job readiness due to YouthWorks.

The Let's Ride to Work Program, in partnership with Lyft, provides up to 40 rides for newly hired employees working in Baltimore City. Thus far, 64 clients have received a total of 1610 rides.

Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD)/Housing

DHCD's Uplands Infrastructure agreement which provides critical funding for Phase II redevelopment construction costs for affordable housing and neighborhood-based retail in the Uplands community is in the process of being executed. The Buy Back the Block project, a DHCD and Live Baltimore Home Center, Inc., partnership to provide additional funding to Baltimore City residents who have been impacted by COVID-19 for down payment assistance has been finalized and is primed for next month's Board of Estimates agenda.

HABC's North Central Park (also known as the Nathaniel J. McFadden Learn and Play Park) and the Perkins II Infrastructure projects are in the development stages.

Department of Planning (DOP)

The grant application period has closed for the Clean Corps initiative. DOP's award will fund six Baltimore-based nonprofits to work in partnership with 15 selected neighborhoods out of a pool of 33 applicants who were determined by several factors including an increase in vacant housing, population decline of 15% or more over the past ten years, and the lowest median income within Baltimore City. The Baltimore-based nonprofits will be selected based on the capacity of the organization, previous work experience, communication plan with selected neighborhoods, and workforce development plan for organization's leaders. The selected awardees will be announced next month.
